The Swedish Demographic Association has established an award for the best thesis at undergraduate or master level. The thesis should be of high quality and have a demographic orientation. The topic of the thesis should therefore relate to population issues in a historical, contemporary or methodological perspective. Innovativeness and creativity regarding subject, perspective or methods are considered, as are actuality and applicability.

Contributions from all academic disciplines are welcome!

The winner will be awarded a stipend of SEK 5000, and will be offered the possibility to present the thesis at a seminar.

To participate

Send your thesis in machine-editable format (MS Word or equivalent) by email to Stefan Öberg (stefan.oberg@econhist.gu.se) together with a short motivation (for example choice of method or subject). Attach a letter of support from your thesis advisor (or equivalent). Add also in the mail:

- Name of all authors, postal address, email and phone number
- The full title of the thesis
- Department and University where the thesis was examined
- Level (undergraduate, magister or master)
- Date of thesis seminar
- Grade awarded to thesis
- Name, title and contact information of supervisor

Deadline for submission is Thursday **February 20, 2014**. Only complete submissions will be reviewed. Only theses examined in 2013 and up to date of submission with at least the degree of “High Pass” (VG in the Swedish system, A, B or C in the ECTS system) or equivalent will be reviewed.

Submissions will be judged anonymously by a jury named by the SDF board. By participating in the competition the author agrees that the thesis may be published on SDFs homepage (www.demografi.se).
