

Travel grant for MA students to Nordic Demographic Symposium 2012 13 – 15 September Tønsberg, Norway

The Nordic Demographic Society has decided to award up to six stipends to MA students, covering the conference fee, accommodation, and travel costs not exceeding NOK 1 500.

Who can receive the grant?

Current or recent master students (graduated after June 2010) studying demography or demography related issues, who are paying members of one of the national demographic societies can receive the grant. The grant holder must present a paper at the Nordic Demographic Symposium.

How to apply?

All candidates for MA grants have to submit abstracts for the symposium. At the same time an extended abstract of 2-4 pages or a full paper should be submitted to the organising committee (nds2012@demografi.no) together with a short letter stating that this is an application for MA travel grant. Please include information about graduation date, or expected graduation date.

Selection process

The decision about who receives the travel grant will be made by a selection committee consisting of one member from each national board. The selection committee will nominate the candidates for the grant (up to six) including at least one candidate from each country. The president of the Nordic Demographic Society is responsible for the process.

Submission deadline is April 1st, 2012
